Member Proposals

Propose a new rule allowing players to call for their own games to be adjudicated under certain conditions to ICCF (Paul Keevil): Proposal defeated.

It was recognised that there is considerable concern about "Dead Man's Defence" amongst our players; some discussion will be invited amongst our membership with a view to making a decision on whether to propose something to the 2023 ICCF Congress.

Domestic Tournaments

The Welsh Championship will be brought forward to this year, RS to organise.

International Tournaments

The British Webserver will commence in December with only two sections of seven teams each.
